Albury Public Art Trail	Various locations in Albury CBD	Follow the online guide to discover Albury's Wodonga's painted walls and sculptural pieces. <u>https://bit.ly/3QEJ9IJ</u>
Albury Riverside Precinct	Wodonga Place, Albury	Enjoy a stroll along the boardwalks by the Murray, BBQs, picnic tables and shade sails.
Albury War Memorial	Take a steep walk up the path from Thurgoona Street, or drive up Memorial Drive, Albury	Opened on Anzac Day 1925, the simple but striking design in topped with a 'torch of liberty'. A good lookout point towards East Albury.
Eastern Hill Lookout	Eastern Hill, East Street, Albury	Lookout offering views of Murray River floodplains and beyond. towards Follow the trail from the carpark to the trig point for spectacular views of the weir spillway and snowy mountains in winter.

Jindera Pioneer Museum	118 Urana Street, Jindera	15 minutes from Albury is the Pioneer Museum set in and around the grounds of a general store and residence built in 1874. Dogs allowed in outdoor spaces and central garden.
Junction Place, Wodonga	Cnr Elgin Blvd and High Streets, Wodonga	Choice of dog-friendly eateries, small green space, monthly markets.
High Country Rail Trail	Cnr Havelock and Osburn Streets, Wodonga	Over 80kms of trail stretching from Wodonga to Shelley. Cycle / walk over 30km of Lake Hume foreshore.
Huon Hill Parklands	Whytes Road, Wodonga	Huon Hill parklands offers views of Lake Hume surrounding valleys and alpine region. Bushwalk, picnic, BBQs and toilets available.
Lake Hume	Various locations	Visit the Hume dam wall, parklands and picnic areas. Swimming, fishing, boating.
Markets	Various locations	Albury Wodonga Farmers Market – every Saturday – Gateway Village On the Border Community Market – every first Sunday of the month, Junction Square Made by Me Market – every fourth Sunday of the month, Junction Square.
McFarlanes Hill	McFarlanes Hill Track, West Wodonga	Tracks and trails over rolling hills and through bushland.
Mungabareena Reserve and Water Works	Mungabareena Reserve, East Albury	Significant cultural reserve on the banks of the Murray River. Picnic area and boat ramp. Water Works is another popular recreation spot for swimming, kayaking, picnics.
Nail Can Hill	Entry via Range Road, Roper Street	Fire and mountain bike trails. Displays of wildflowers during spring. Good vantage / lookout points.
Noreuil Park	Wodonga Place, South Albury	Leafy river foreshore. Swimming, kayaking. Perfect place for picnics and BBQs. River Deck Café and playgrounds are in the vicinity. Nearby off-leash dog area with river access at Oddies Creek.
The Crossing Place Trail	Lemke Road, Gateway Island, Wodonga	5.1km walking / bike loop featuring sculptural works from local Aboriginal artists.
Wagirra Trail	Access via the riverside parklands.	Jump on the Wagirra Trail following the Murray River from South Albury to Wonga Wetlands.
Yindyamarra Sculpture Walk	Access via Kremur Street, Albury	Follow alongside the Murray River and back through the wetlands, passing by 15 Indigenous sculptures. Dogs on lead
