Walk, cycle or paddle. From the banks of the iconic Murray River to the endless vistas found along our extensive walking and cycling tracks, Albury Wodonga is the perfect place to find your natural high.





Naturally curious

Discover over 100 kilometres of trails and paths by foot or pedal. Every spring, the surrounding hills explode into a patchwork of vibrant wildflowers. Find your serenity (and maybe a glimpse of the endangered Crimson Spider Orchid) on Nail Can Hill.

From atop **Huon Hill**, take in a 360-degree view of Albury Wodonga and the surrounding landscape, including the peaks of Mount Bogong and Feathertop.

Take up a spot in one of the many bird hides to spot some 350 species of birdlife that call the peaceful **Wonga Wetlands** home.





On the lake

Holding six times the volume of Sydney Harbour, **Lake Hume** is an easy 15 minute drive from the city centres and a must-see on any Albury Wodonga itinerary. A mecca for boating, fishing, swimming and watersports, the lake is picture perfect from sunrise to sunset.

Get out on the water with **Adventure Ski**. They will have you wakeboarding, tubing or cruising the lake with ease.

Don't forget to stop by and marvel at the complexity and sheer size of the **Hume**Dam Wall before popping into The Boat

Shed for a woodfired pizza and cocktails on the deck.







The mighty Murray River

The newly developed **Murray River Precinct** is at the heart of our river experience. Take a stroll along the boardwalks before exploring the playgrounds on the lush lawns of **Noreuil Park** and **Oddies Creek Park**.

If you're feeling adventurous, hit the water in a canoe or kayak from Murray River Canoe Hire. For ancient stories from the Aboriginal Dreaming, join Giilangyaldhaanygalang - Wiradjuri Storytellers for a tour along the riverside Yindyamarra Sculpture Walk.

There's always something new to see and experience. Art lovers can escape the sun and immerse themselves in surprising stories at the Albury LibraryMuseum, or enjoy the connection of art and literature in the cool spaces at Hyphen - Wodonga Library Gallery.

Open 363 days a year, family-friendly and free, Murray Art Museum Albury (MAMA) combines heritage buildings with contemporary architecture and is home to ever-changing exhibitions.

No visit is complete without a stop at Bonegilla Migrant Experience. Did you know that one in twenty Australians has a link to Bonegilla Migrant Camp?

For a fascinating insight into our past, pick up an Albury CBD Historic Walking Tour map from the Visitor Information Centre and take yourself on a self-quided trip through time. Circle past the prominent Art Deco. T&G Tower, in the heart of Albury before visiting the heritage-listed Albury Railway Station, featuring the longest covered train platform in the southern hemisphere, at more than 450 metres long.





Shopping

Wander our eclectic shopping scene, from laneways full of charming local boutiques to your favorite brands at **Myer Centrepoint**.

Keen home chefs will be inspired by the finest local and imported ingredients at **Season To Taste**. Pop into **The Real Florist** and pick up a bright bunch of blooms or a beautiful local gift to take home. Insider tip – you can grab a coffee while you're there!





Sip and savour

Embrace warm days and long nights at one of Albury Wodonga's many venues. Kick back outside at **The Star Hotel** or catch river views at **The Lincoln**. Don't miss Church on Sundays, with live music at **Church St Hotel**.

Check out the beer garden at the historic **Sodens Hotel** - once home to horse stables that housed the great Phar Lap en route to the Melbourne Cup. Their indoor play area will also be a hit with the kids.

Beer lovers will find their happy place at Murray Towns Brewing Co. or The Thirsty Devil Brewery, while the wine-curious can jump on a Sip and Pour Wine Tour of our local wine regions.

Across the river, **Belvoir Park** wraps around a charming lake and features a Ninja Warrior course alongside an accessible adventure playground with liberty swing. Bring your dog for a run in the off-leash fenced dog park with two agility courses, or simply enjoy the views from the barbecue seating area.

If big drop-ins are more your style, **Albury Skate Park** has got you covered. Let loose on the pump track and skate bowls, or test your skills on the vert ramp. The recently redeveloped skate precinct also features a basketball court, barbecues and picnic tables - the perfect spot to take in all the action!







Events and festivals

There's so much to explore this season, like **Music in the Gardens**, set in the historic Albury Botanic Gardens. Enjoy live entertainment while relaxing on the cool lawns at this free summer series. Sample the regions finest produce at the **North East Food and Wine Festival**. The twilight market includes live music, roaming performers and the ever-popular Kids Zone.
